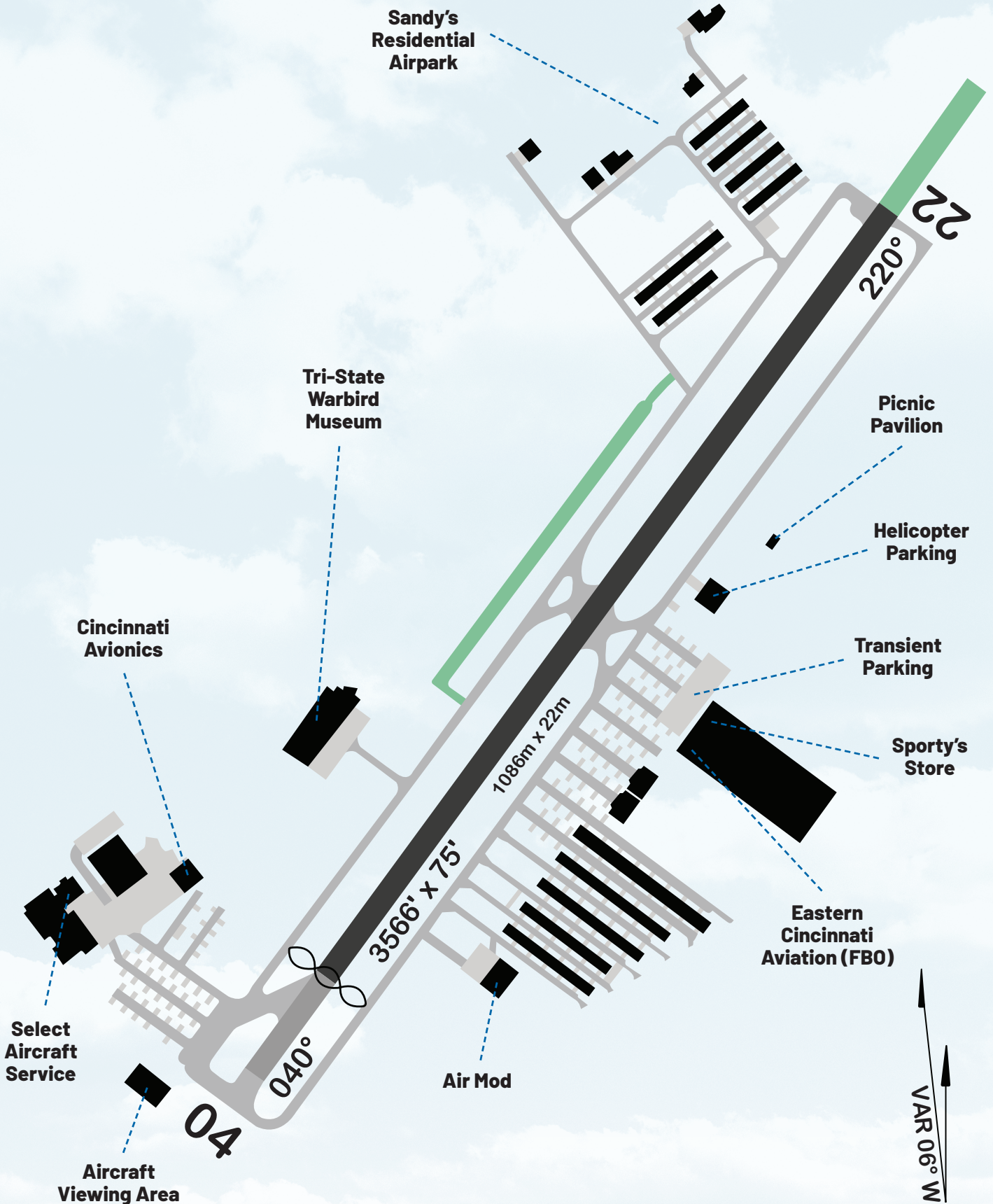
Combine your visit
